Trail Courtesy and Skier Responsibility

There are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

1. Maintain control of your speed & direction at all times.
2. Ski in a manner that does not endanger others.
3. Don't stop where you obstruct a trail or aren't visible.
4. Obey signs & posted warnings & keep off closed trails.
5. Be aware of changing conditions & natural & man-made obstacles that exist. Snow making and grooming activities are routinely in progress on trails. Use caution on designated trails.
6. Yield track to faster skiers coming down hill.
7. Do not walk/hike on ski trails. No pets on ski trails.
8. Do not ski without a trail pass.
9. Remove skis & snow shoes before crossing road.

Emergency Procedures

- Keep injured person warm and quiet.
- Report to ski patrol at Ski Center: 973-702-1222 or High Point State Park Office: 973-875-4800 about emergencies.
- Never leave injured person alone unless necessary.
- Any witness to an accident should leave name & address.

Best Viewpoint Area

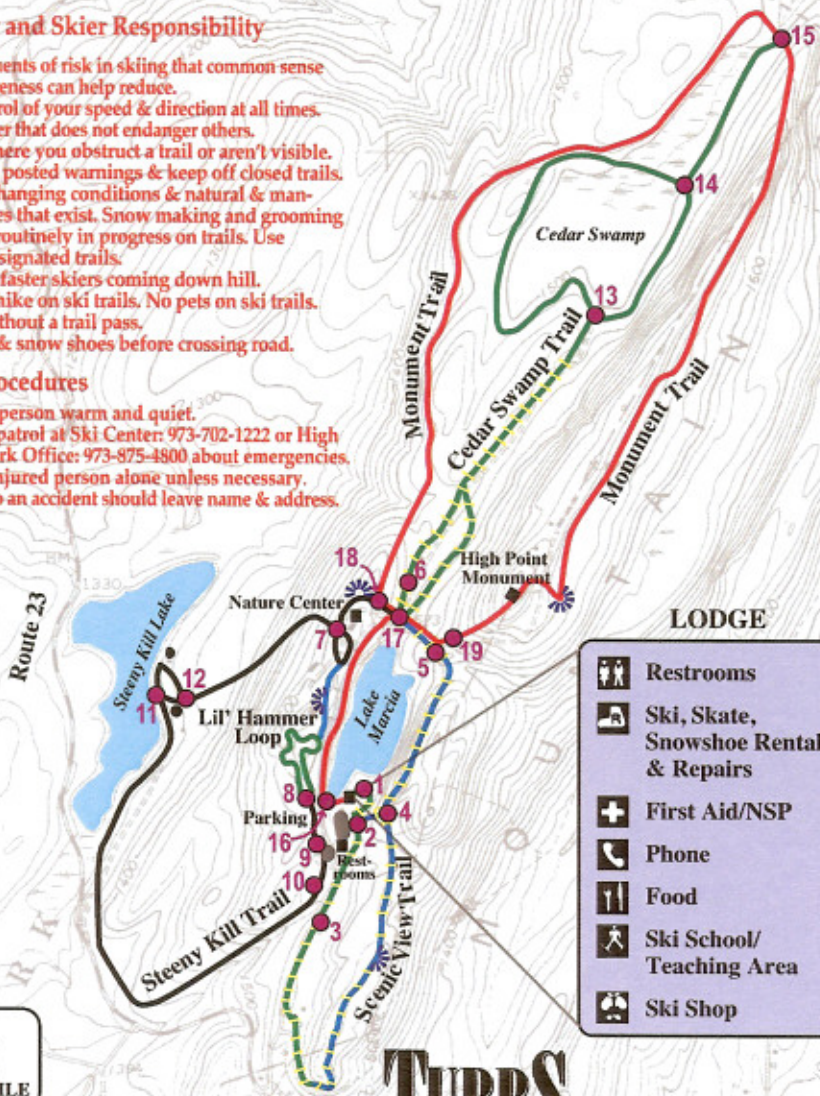
